The first is that **Mrs Anderson will be retiring** from her role as Deputy Headteacher this Easter. I am extremely proud of the way in which the school has developed over the past four and a half years and feel that now is the best time to hand the running of the school to somebody new. Isaac Newton is an extremely special school so we will ensure that we appoint a great replacement.

It has been another extremely busy and successful week here at school. I would like to say a huge thank you to all of those members of the school community who came to the Rotary Club Swimarathon last Sunday. It was



incredible to fill each lane in the pool and a tremendous effort by all. We have raised over £1500 for the rotary club which is fantastic.

On Tuesday we competed in the St Hughs Year 5 football tournament. We progressed to the final which eventually went to penalties. After a few tense moments we managed to win the shoot out and were declared the tournament winners. A huge congratulations to all who played.
