


Homework– Year 1 and Year 2 Summer Term: Dinosaurs

Find out which is the most popular dinosaur in your house and record the results on a block graph. Write three questions that could be answered using your graph.	Write a recount of our trip to the Museum.
Borrow a dinosaur book from library. Share it with your family or bring it to school.		What can you find out about dinosaurs? Research dinosaurs: How long ago did they live on Earth? Why did they die out?
Create your own dinosaur picture, using paint, paper and fabric. Make a dinosaur model, using plasticine or old cardboard boxes, bottles and yoghurt pots.	Choose a dinosaur to describe, using interesting describing words.	Share what you know about dinosaurs with your family.
