<p>A little maths question for you - If one pig has 5 bricks and another pig has 4 bricks. How many bricks do they have altogether? Draw a picture to help you or use your fingers.</p>	<p>Can you find matching items around the home? Pairs of socks, matching shoes, making patterns, look for matching number around the home etc.</p>	<p>Can you make a Troll out of things around the home? You can use paper, junk, materials, anything you like.</p>
