Add facts, pictures, diagrams.</p>	<p><u>Library</u></p> <p>Borrow a book on the environment, living things and their habitats or sound and hearing from the library. Share it with your family or bring it to school.</p>	<p><u>Letter</u></p> <p>Write a letter giving reasons why our school should begin to recycle plastic.</p>
<p><u>Art</u></p> <p>Design and make an model out of plastic objects. Create a collage using recyclable materials. You don't have to use paper or glue.</p>		<p><u>Recycling Diary</u></p> <p>Create a 'Recycling Diary' and record what you recycle or reuse.</p>
<p><u>Poster</u></p> <p>Design a poster persuading people to recycle, explaining why.</p>	<p><u>Living things and their habitats</u></p> <p>Choose a living thing and design a suitable habitat for it so it has everything it needs– food, shelter etc. Draw the habitat and label it.</p>	<p><u>Sound and Hearing</u></p> <p>Investigate different sounds you can make in your house and write a list. Can you group them according to whether they are loud or soft, high or low?</p>
