

School Leaders

Sports Committee - 12

Two children from each house are elected as House Captains, together with the Bronze Ambassadors make up the sports committee. They meet each half term to discuss various sporting competitions and events. The committee is responsible for organising the intra house competitions that are held each term and they attend various sporting competitions and events that are held in conjunction with Inspire+.

Bronze Ambassadors - 4

Two Bronze Ambassadors are selected by the PE department to represent the school and to assist with various sporting festivals and competitions arranged by Inspire+. They are also required to promote events and challenges through assemblies.

Aspire Leaders – 3

Three children from Year 6 lead and manage a club for the less active population within school. This takes place every Thursday lunchtime and assisted by Inspire+ through equipment and lesson plans

Change 4 Life Leaders – 4

Four children from Year 6 lead and manage a Change 4 Life Club on a Wednesday Lunchtime. They encourage and support children from Year 3 and 4 to participate in a wide range of activities, centred on the Sainsburys School Games.

Playground Leaders - 10

Children are responsible for organising and managing activities for children to enjoy on the playground at lunchtimes. These involve a variety of team games, with the leaders arranging children in readiness for the activities.
