Free School Meals Supermarket Vouchers

A £15 supermarket voucher was sent out via email this week to all Parents/Carers of children who are eligible for free school meals (pupil premium). Each child is entitled to one £15 voucher. PE and Sport Update

Things have been incredibly busy this term in PE lessons.

Miss Freeman and Miss Jones' class have begun their Tennis Coaching sessions with Lewis from Grantham

Tennis Club. Year 2 have begun to understand how to hold a racquet correctly and ball control. Year 6 have been working on hitting the ball with increasing control and learning to place the ball where they want it on court. These sessions will continue after half term for Mrs Gaze's and Mrs Roberts' classes.



All of Year 5 have been fortunate to have a specialist Tag Rugby coach from Inspire+ for their lessons this term. They have covered controlling the ball, passing and moving. All children have thoroughly enjoyed their sessions, all increasing their confidence in playing tag rugby.




How to control your privacy

Snapchat is a photo and video messaging app with approximately 180 Million daily users.

As a messaging service, there are no option to make your account private but you can control who can see your location, who can message you and who can see your Stories.

From the main screen, click on the profile icon in the top left corner, then click on the gear symbol on the next screen. This will take you to your Snapchat settings




You have the ability to ensure only your friends - people you have accepted can see what you have shared on your Story, or even select which friends can see your Story.

You can also choose who can contact you and set it so that only your friends can send you Snaps


How to block other users
