We were delighted to receive a tweet to the school twitter account about Phoenix this week. She managed to win the Cliffedale Chandlers under nine table tennis competition – well done!

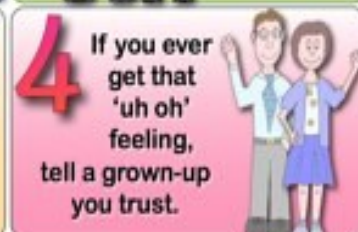
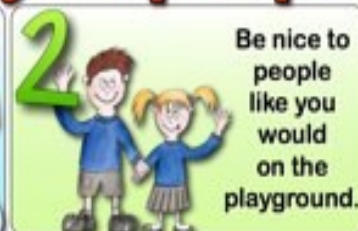
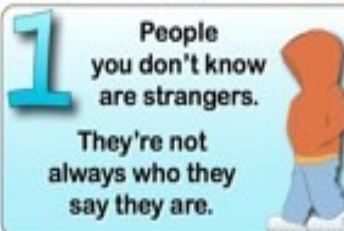
Year 3 Residential
