Year 5's view on Life at Isaac Newton School



WHAT ARE THE RISKS? NGL (which stands for Not Gonna Lie') is an app through which were share a link to their instagram story or Twitter account; inviting their followers to give anonymous feedback. The app includes some prewritten questions (such as if you could change anything about me, what would it bet'), plus the option to ask followers to simply send me anonymous messages'.
