<p><u>Viking Long Boat</u></p> <p>Make a Viking long boat using junk and collage materials.</p>	<p><u>Library</u></p> <p>Borrow a book on the Anglo-Saxons, the Vikings, electricity, solids, liquids and gases or erosion of coasts from the library. Share it with your family or bring it to school.</p>	<p><u>The Anglo-Saxons and the Vikings in Britain</u></p> <p>Research the Anglo-Saxons or the Vikings and create your own fact sheet. You could present it as a booklet and include pictures and diagrams.</p>
<p><u>Jewellery</u></p> <p>Design a piece of Viking jewellery, such as a necklace.</p>		<p><u>What the Vikings brought to Britain</u></p> <p>Investigate what the Vikings brought to Britain that we still have today, such as words or place names.</p>
<p><u>Rivers and Coasts</u></p> <p>Research types of landscapes such as rivers and coasts and how they are being affected by erosion. Create an information sheet or leaflet. Add pictures and diagrams.</p>	<p><u>Electricity</u></p> <p>Investigate sources of electricity in your house and write a list.</p>	<p><u>States of Matter</u></p> <p>Make a list of different solids (such as ice), liquids (water) and gases (steam). Can you think of one fact about solids, liquids and gases?</p>
